

# Oasis High School to Cabrillo College Summer/Fall 2019

## Instructions for Dual Enrollment for NEW Oasis High School Students

### ❑ APPLICATION:

- Apply at Cabrillo.edu by selecting Admissions and then Apply for Admission.
- Select U.S. Students Apply and create an OpenCCC account.
- You will use this account to apply each term so **WRITE DOWN YOUR OPENCCC USER NAME AND PASSWORD.**
- **For high school select: Santa Cruz County Community.**
- Be sure to choose a major - not undeclared. You can change it at any time later.
- When you receive your Cabrillo Student ID# in your email, go to WebAdvisor on Cabrillo.edu and create your password. You will use this email and password continually, so **PLEASE WRITE THEM DOWN!**
- All score reports (AP, IB, CAASP) to clear prerequisites may be submitted to Cabrillo Admissions and Records.

### ❑ ORIENTATION:

- Use cabrillo.edu to log-in to your WebAdvisor account and complete the online orientation.
- Print the certificate at the end of the orientation.
- Review the New to WebAdvisor tutorial.

### ❑ PLACEMENT AND PLANNING:

- Cabrillo College uses Guided Self-Placement to help you decide which math and English courses to take first.
- From the Admissions menu, select **Assessment Placement Testing.**
- Select the [Start Here: Guided Self Placement.](#)
  - **Option 1: Online Guided Self-Placement** is available online through WebAdvisor eForms. **Be sure to select the Submit button.**
  - **Option 2: In-person:** Attend a **Placement and Planning Workshop** to help you through the process. Students must know their Cabrillo ID# and password and provide a copy of most recent high school transcript. ### ❑ DUAL ENROLLMENT FORM:

- Complete the Dual Enrollment form provided by Oasis. A Cabrillo College counselor signature is required for more than 6 units. When enrolling in more than 11 units, tuition will be required for all units (no high school waiver applies).
- **Review the Course Descriptions in the Cabrillo online catalog.** For **NEW** Oasis students, it is typically best to enroll in any of the following courses:
  - COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE CG1: College Success
  - COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE CG51: College Planning
  - COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE CG52: College Study Skills
  - COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE CG54: Careers and Lifestyles
  - FOREIGN LANGUAGE (SPANISH, ASL, FRENCH, JAPANESE):  
Not required for graduation from Oasis High School. If the student has successfully completed some high school foreign language coursework, they may not have to start with the elementary level at Cabrillo. Please consult a Cabrillo counselor and/or the admissions departments of any university to which the student will apply.
  - MATH: Students typically do best in a four-day per week math class and students are strongly encouraged to take the Cabrillo Math Plus course for whatever math class they are planning to take.
  - KIN: Cabrillo offers a vast selection of P.E. classes
  - ART, THEATRE ARTS, DANCE, MUSIC: These are typically high-interest, low credit, highly time-consuming courses.
- Submit the completed and signed dual enrollment form to Cabrillo Admissions & Welcome Center, Sac East 225.

### ❑ REGISTER FOR COURSES:

- Registration for Dual Enrolled Students begins May 23rd.
- The student will be able to register for open sections of approved courses through WebAdvisor according to the registration priority date/time posted in the student's WebAdvisor account.
